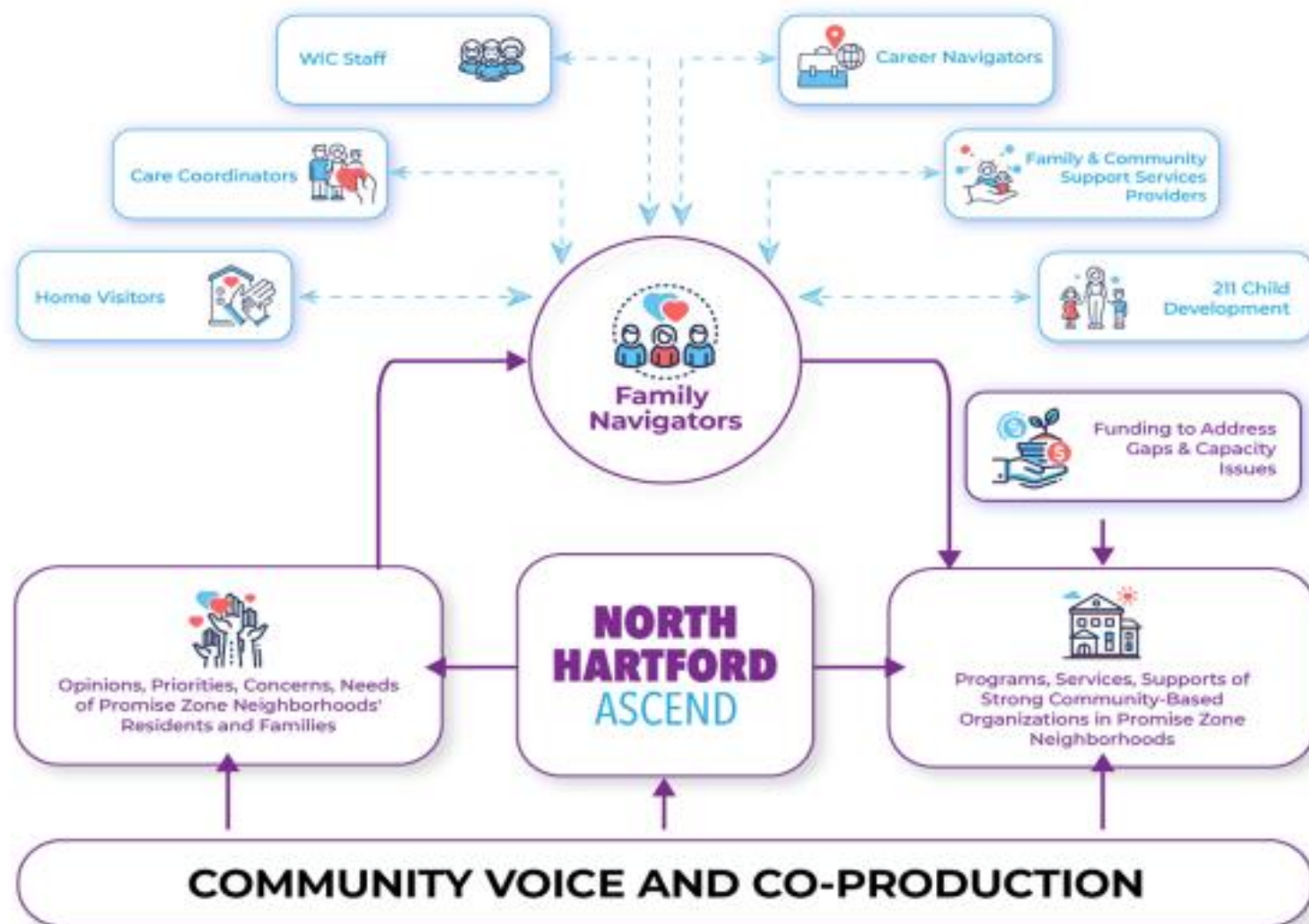
Discussion Guidelines

What is the Ascend Mapping Tool?

- **Requested by Ascend community to:**
 - Locate programs, services & neighborhood resources
 - **Target audience:** residents, providers, Family Navigators
- Collaboratively developed by the Hartford Data Collaborative (including 211 resource directory)
- Map accessible by phone/tablet to locate services closest to you by:
 - Type of service (childcare, afterschool programming)
 - Age group

The North Hartford Ascend Pipeline (NHAP) is a cradle to career effort to ensure children living in the North Hartford Promise Zone – which includes the Clay Arsenal, Northeast, and Upper Albany neighborhoods – have the supports they need to reach their full potential. The goal of this tool is to visually present NHAP pipeline providers and community resources, and to understand the service catchment population using recent data. This tool allows users to explore services by location and resource type.
